Who and What is Medcin?

- The Medcin Engine was developed by Medicomp Systems
- A system of standardized medical terminology, is a proprietary medical vocabulary. Medcin is a point-of-care terminology, intended for use in Electronic Health Record systems.
- It includes over 250,000 clinical data elements encompassing symptoms, history, physical examination, tests, diagnoses and therapy.
- Medcin Engine combines a robust database of medical concepts with methods for presenting and documenting relevant symptoms, history, physical findings, tests, diagnoses and therapy for virtually any patient presentation.












Test and Validation - Review

Your tech will provide the outputs from each of these queries for the application team to review and take action with





Production Updates and Go Live

- Make changes to Notes, Flowsheets, etc prior to running the Medcin Update
- Backup always
- Off hours update
- Validate





Communication

- Most organizations will notify users of changes to their environment, same goes for Medcin Updates
- Super User channel, email, other training vehicles





Process Overview

- Review content of the latest Medcin Quarterly Update
- Update the TEST or QA Environment
- Review and Identify the impacts
- Make the necessary changes Updates in Test, Updates in Prod
- Apply update to Production
- Communicate to end users
