




Episode of Care



- The CMMS announces organizations selected to participate in 1st round of BPCI
- Bundled Payments for Care Improvement initiative
- 4 Models
- 48 Initial Episodes of Care
- 30, 60, 90 day periods

- 5 year demonstration (1991-1996)
- Heart Bypass surgery
- 90 day post discharge episode of care
- \$50.3 million saved

Cardiac, Spine & other select surgeries

- Obtain care from 1 of 6 Center of Excellence Hospitals
- Employees bear NO out of pocket costs (travel, lodging, meals, copays)
- Reimbursed a single bundled payment
 - that includes all physician and hospital costs associated with both inpatient and outpatient pre- and post-operative care.



Medicaid

- Arkansas Health Care Payment Improvement Initiative
 - o CHF
 - Upper respiratory infection
 - o Perinatal
 - Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder
 - Total join replacement (hip & knee).
- Ohio and Tennessee similar programs



- Collaborate with other providers during transitions of care


Intuitive user experience...

- Filter data and escalate outliers










What is a Care Plan?


A road map guiding everyone involved in a patient's care



Timeline is critical for patients in 30, 60, or 90 day bundles.




Each Phase of Care can have multiple activities






Each activity can have multiple tasks






Tasks are assigned to users




- This can be different for each organization.

A Care Plan is assigned to a patient










Pre-Op evaluation with dynamic scoring is completed




Lower scores = higher risk








Dashboard identifies off-plan patients and activities
